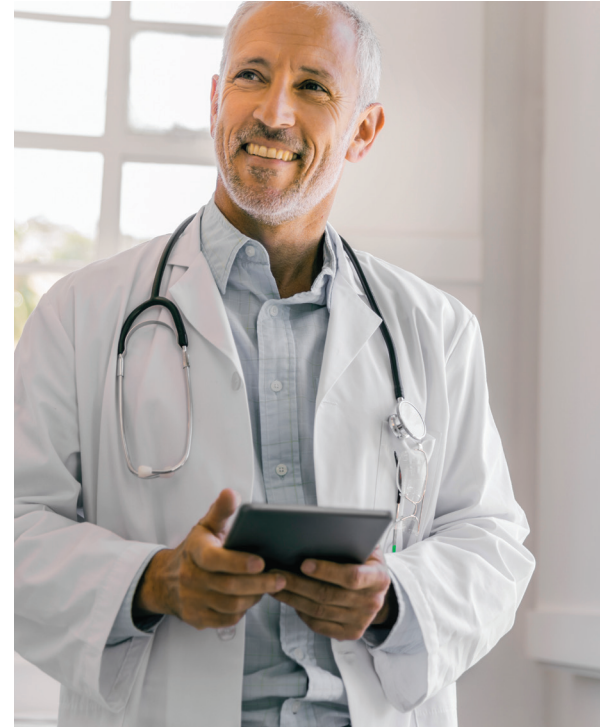

7. Enter the required information.
